A chance encounter at a student clinic led to a lifelong pursuit to conduct much-needed research on the stuttering condition in bilingual people. She was frustrated by the limited body of work available addressing this growing patient population and vowed to fill the information void in the hopes her research can be of value for speech-language practitioners as our communities become more diverse.

Dr. Medina is extending the conventional limits of research as a vehicle for academic and practical contribution into a platform for advocacy to help people with the stuttering condition confidently own their voice and overcome personal and societal limitations to be heard with respect and understanding.
